Summary of Collegiate Recovery Community and Housing Opportunity

Nebraska's new Collegiate Recovery Community (CRC) will support a student's decision to remain sober by connecting students with a community of like-minded peers.

"Recovery doesn't need to be any more difficult than it already is and that is why we are here to lend a hand to anyone in need of our support," said Jon Haag, a founding member of the recovery community.

We are very fortunate to have the support of partners like University Housing to provide a residence hall experience for students in recovery. The residential recovery community in the Selleck Quadrangle will provide single rooms for each resident, a floor TV lounge and space for recovery meetings/programming, a central campus location with convenient access to dining and a large kitchen open to all residents. Students can be part of the CRC without living in Selleck but there are many benefits to living together with other students in recovery.

The Collegiate Recovery Community offers the following services to students in recovery:

- Social support and fellowship with other students who are in recovery
- On-campus recovery meetings
- Opportunities for leadership in the Collegiate Recovery Community
- Financial assistance in the form of scholarships of at least \$500
- Referrals to specialized services such as individual counseling, well-being coaching, tutoring, and financial aid

Requirements for joining the CRC

1. Accepted to University of Nebraska-Lincoln
2. Abstinence from using drugs and/or alcohol (length of time abstinent is considered on an individual basis)
3. Complete Application Process
 - a. Application for CRC (this form)
 - b. Obtain three letters of recommendation from individuals who can attest to your recovery. It will be your responsibility to gather these letters and email them to cboehm3@unl.edu.
